Hamilton, and Assistant Superintendent, Dr. Jeff Corey Gorman, are also planning a **Special Media Evening** presentation for the **October 20** session when MTHS juniors will receive their iPad devices. Media representatives are welcome to attend the **October 20** session anytime between 4-8 PM to cover the evening's iPad device deployment activities.

MTHS Principal, Robert Goodall, and his building administrative team sent letters to all MTHS parents and students inviting them to attend one of these exciting Deployment Nights, where each student will receive his or her brand new pre-configured iPad learning device to use for classwork and homework during the 2011-2012 school year. All MTHS students must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Once admitted, students and parents will hear a keynote presentation by Principal Goodall, see a demonstration on the iPad security features and a brief iPad demonstration by two teachers; and then sign out their new learning devices. Parents and students will also enjoy light refreshments while they take a quick baseline technology survey in the Media Center.

Bond referendum funds that were part of the construction allotments for the new Monroe Township High School were used by the Monroe Township Board of Education to purchase the iPad devices for all of MTHS students.
